

URGENT COMMUNICATION from the TRAINEESHIP OFFICE concerning the TRAVEL ALLOWANCE

Dear Blue Book Trainees,

There appears to be some confusion on the procedure to claim travel allowance payment.

On behalf of and with the approval of the Traineeships Office (henceforth T.O.) we would like to clarify some of the most common **issues and misunderstandings** that have been detected so far among the trainees.

- The T.O. has the right to check the ticket reservation that you have uploaded and submitted from the moment of submission until **2 years after the end of your traineeship** (28th of February 2020). Therefore, you have to be in possession of all your travel tickets (including the return ticket) if you have **ALREADY** submitted your claim.
- Once you have submitted your travel allowance claim, there will be no chance to modify it. This means that you cannot submit your claim for a return ticket at another moment, and that you should submit both ways' claim at the same time.

If you have already submitted a one-way ticket claim and in the light of this communication you would like to amend it, contact the T.O. directly at EAC BUREAU DES STAGES <u>Eac-Stages@ec.europa.eu</u> as soon as possible, and they will re-open your file and let you update it.

- If your journey back home is **by car**, and the T.O. asks you for proof, you will be asked to submit your proof of travel within one month from the end of your traineeship. This is the **ONLY** exception.
- Remember that if you changed your place of residence between the moment you applied and the beginning of the traineeship, and the new place of residence corresponds to a higher distance band, you are obliged to upload your travel tickets in the same PDF file which includes the proof for place of origin/residence.

If you still have questions or doubts, or if you consider your case atypical, please ASK FOR A FACE-TO-FACE MEETING WITH THE TRAINEESHIP OFFICE.

EURid is the registry manager of the .eu and .eю (Cyrillic script) country code top-level domains upon appointment of the European Commission in 2003. They work with around 700 partners worldwide — accredited registrars — that register **domain names** for their customers.

Any company, individual or organisation residing in the European Union or in Iceland, Liechtenstein or Norway can register a .eu or .eo domain name. You will find out about several success stories about people and companies that reaped the benefits of choosing .eu or its variants in other scripts.
