The conference will provide a space for European institutions, employers, and young people themselves to share views on quality traineeships. This event will bring key actors together to raise awareness about existing quality frameworks for traineeships within the EU, discuss

challenges and showcase promising practices.

## .EU, your Digital European Identity

**EURid** is the registry manager of the .eu and .ею (Cyrillic script) country code top-level domains upon appointment of the European Commission in 2003. They work with around 700 partners worldwide – accredited registrars – that register **domain names** for their customers.



Any company, individual or organisation

residing in the European Union or in Iceland, Liechtenstein or Norway can register a **.eu** or **.eю** domain name. You will find out about several success stories about people and companies that reaped the benefits of choosing .eu or its variants in other scripts.



The event will feature the presence of representatives from **CENTR (Council of European National Top level Registries)**, to provide a high level course on the structure of the Domain Name System, and representatives from EURid to explain its role as the .eu registry operator.
